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Preface

This volume contains the 41 contributed papers and three invited papers presented at the 9th Annual European Symposium on Algorithms, held in Århus, Denmark, 28–31 August 2001. ESA 2001 continued the sequence:

The proceedings of these previous meetings were published as Springer LNCS volumes 726, 855, 979, 1136, 1284, 1461, 1643, and 1879.

Papers were solicited in all areas of algorithmic research, including approximations algorithms, combinatorial optimization, computational biology, computational geometry, databases and information retrieval, external-memory algorithms, graph and network algorithms, machine learning, online algorithms, parallel and distributed computing, pattern matching and data compression, randomized algorithms, and symbolic computation. Algorithms could be sequential, distributed, or parallel, and should be analyzed either mathematically or by rigorous computational experiments. Experimental and applied research were especially encouraged.

Each extended abstract submitted was read by at least three referees, and evaluated on its quality, originality, and relevance to the symposium. The entire Program Committee met at Paderborn University on 12–13 May 2001 and selected 41 papers for presentation from the 102 submissions. These, together with three invited papers by Susanne Albers, Lars Arge, and Uri Zwick, are included in this volume.
